Presidents Corner

Dear Members & Friends of the Danish Club Ltd,

A big welcome to 2011, which should prove to be a transforming year for the Danish Club Ltd.

At the AGM on Sunday 28 November 2010, the Committee informed the members that we have been approached by a party interested in buying the Club House and taking over the Crown Lease for the land. The Committee elaborated on the pros and cons associated with the sale of the Club House and recommended to members that we progress negotiations until a clear position and offer is available for members to vote on at an extraordinary general meeting; to be called at such time. The Committee received such mandate from the AGM.

In view of the upcoming negotiations, and the ongoing liaison with our partners in the Club House, the Swedish Council of NSW, the outgoing Committee accepted re-election subject to its main focus being the sale of the Club House and exit of the Crown Lease for the land.

Following the AGM, the Committee has proceeded with sales negotiations and with investigations of terms and conditions in relation to transfer of the Crown Lease. At this point in time we are awaiting the outcome of a Committee meeting within the prospective buyer's organisation.

In addition to the above activities, the Committee has also undertaken business as usual activities such as completion of reporting tasks to ASIC, preparation and submission of our multi-function Liquor Licence for the period to February 2012, and indeed planning of a Sunday Lunch Function for Sunday 27 March. A working Bee at the Club House is also on the agenda and will be planned at the upcoming meeting in the Scandinavian Association.

The re-elected Club Committee comprises: Niels Mathiesen, Hans Jensen, Finn Kenvil, Peter Madvig and Henning Juhl. Lisbeth Hansen continues as our Web Master. Hans is Secretary, Niels is the holder of our Liquor Licence and manager of the bar, and Henning Juhl is President and Treasurer.

The Committee will maintain contact and broad collaboration with other Clubs and organisations; notably the Danish Radio on SBS and the Danish Church. If you have any suggestions or matters you wish to draw to our attention then please contact the Committee via our web site email contact, or via phone. Your thoughts and feedback are always most welcome.

Steen Handlos Andersen: 19.11.1941 - 28.02.2011

Steen Handlos Andersen passed away on Monday 28th February after a period of illness. Our thoughts are with his beloved wife Ludmilla, children Natasha and Igor, brothers Kjeld and Erik, and his extended family. Steen arrived in Australia in the late 60'ies and was active on many fronts. In his early years, he was an active president of the Viking Soccer Club. He served 3 periods as president of the Scandinavian Business Club Inc. Steen was a very proud and active member of the Royal Danish Guards Society Australia and he served as its president and secretary in 2007. Having served as a sergeant in the Royal Danish Guards, Steen participated proudly in the 350 years anniversary celebrations in Copenhagen in 2008.
