Dear Members and Friends of the Danish Club, we have commenced a new financial year and the Committee wish to update you on matters of importance to the Club.

Financial Report for the year ended 30 June 2011.

The Australian Securities & Investment Commission has changed its requirements in regards to lodgement of Annual Accounts for small companies. That is, companies such as The Danish Club Ltd no longer have to submit accounts audited by an ASIC registered Auditor. Such auditing is a major expense item for the Club. The Committee is therefore recommending that the Club is self-auditing the Accounts for the year ended 30 June 2011 prior to submission to ASIC. We are therefore inviting financial members to join the Committee in conducting a detailed self-audit & review of the Accounts on Sunday 21 August, at 11:00am. The traditional big Sunday Lunch will be open for everyone from 12:30.

Sale of Club House

Two further parties have expressed an interest in the Club House, making it total 4 parties with an active interest. The major obstacle to concluding matters is a delay in response from the Minister regarding either outright purchase of the crown land upon transaction or certainty in regards to the ongoing lease conditions post July-2020. We hope to have matters resolved short term. This will include an Ideas & Discussion Paper on what's next for the Club.

We need helpers for both days at the Club House and selling Hot Dogs, if you can spare an hour here and there then please, contact details are:

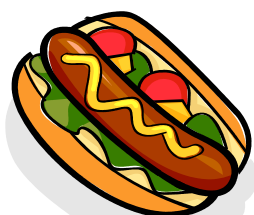
